The code prints two lines: count: with how many guesses it took to find N, and answer: with the value of N. Hints: If the halfway value is exactly in between two integers, choose the smaller one.

low = 0
high = 1001
guess = (high+low)//2
count = 1
while guess != N:
    if guess < N:
    low = guess
    elif guess > N:
    high = guess
    guess = (high+low)//2
count += 1
print("count:",count)
print("answer:",guess)
```

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
