Typically, I read the mud responses

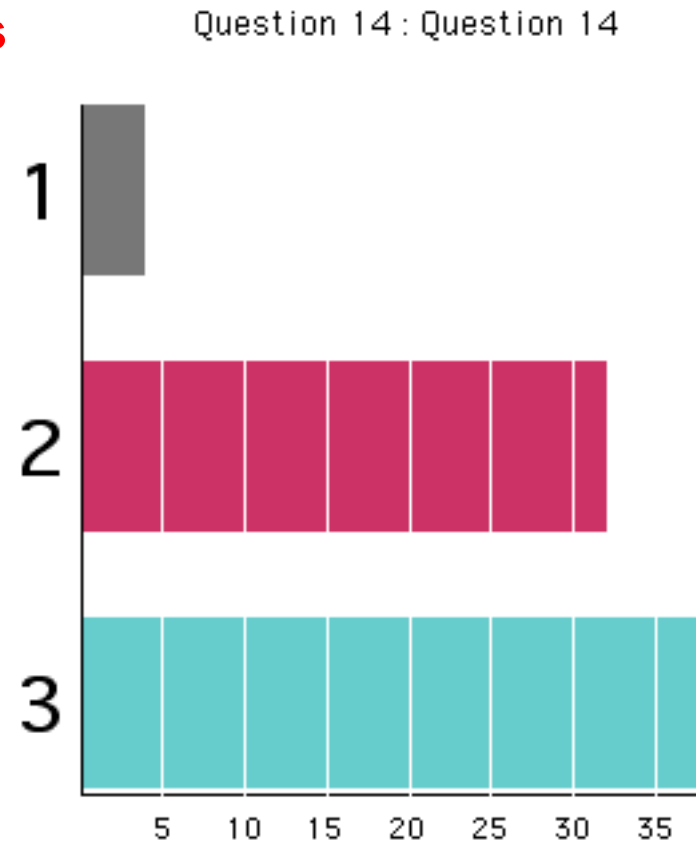
