$$\hat{\sigma}^2 = 1.5, \ \hat{\beta} = (1,2,1)^T, \ (X^T X)^{-1} = \begin{pmatrix} 2 & 1 & 0 \\ 1 & 2 & 1 \\ 0 & 1 & 2 \end{pmatrix}.$$

Test the hypothesis

$$H_0: \beta_1 = 4 - 2\beta_3 \text{ and } \beta_2 = 0.5 + \beta_3$$

at the level of significance $\alpha = 0.05$.
