Topics to think about for final class:

- -what can be learned from thinking about competing *theories* of capitalism?
- -what can be learned from thinking about various *ethnographies* of capitalism that we read?
- -how do we think about them in comparison to the other? What do we learn from each?
- -what is potentially learned by thinking about capitalism in relation to its "others", i.e. various forms of socialism?
- -What questions does thinking about financial crisis of 2008 as an ethnographic problem raise for you?
- -In your mind, what are most important issues moving forward in thinking about "capitalism" as an issue?
