# Aeneas at Pallanteum (Rome) I

- Festival of Hercules at Ara Maxima (113-361)
  - o Evander quickly agrees to alliance (143-201)
  - o Evander tells story of Hercules and Cacus (213-316)
- Tour of Pallanteum (Rome) (361-435)
  - Age of Saturn
  - Altar and Gate of Carmentis; Asylum; Lupercal; Argiletum; Capitoline;
    Forum; Carinae; Palatine

#### **Venus and Vulcan**


- Venus persuades Vulcan to make arms for Aeneas (435-490)
- Vulcan to Vulcania to make arms (490-535)


## Aeneas at Pallanteum (Rome) II

- Evander tells of Caeretans' need for a foreign leader against Mezentius; offers his son Pallas and 400 cavalry (564-614)
- Sign from Venus: war is coming and armor is ready (615-638)
- Evander's emotional goodbye to Pallas (653-690)
- Army of Aeneas and Pallas rides to Caere (690-716)

## The Shield of Aeneas

- Venus presents arms to Aeneas (716-738)
- Description of the Shield (738-853)
  - o Romulus and Remus and the she-wolf
  - o Rape of the Sabine Women
  - War then Peace between Romans and Sabines
  - o Execution of Mettus, dictator of Alba Longa
  - o Porsenna besieges Rome; Cocles and Cloelia
  - o The Gauls occupy Rome, 390 BC
  - o Roman religious guilds: Salii, Luperci, matrons
  - o Underworld: Catiline in Tartarus; Cato in Elysium
  - o Battle of Actium, 31 BC
  - o Octavian's Triple Triumph at Rome, 29 BC
