11. Sandstone white, and brownish, being quarried at Newton Mearns road. On top of it there is tough blueish boulder clay which is rotted into a brownish boulder clay for a distance of 8 feet down.

12. Deep boulder clay cutting E of road.

Note:—In all the cuttings there were a few highland rocks seen, but no granite: plenty of limestones ~~from~~ and sandstones from Carboniferous rocks.

The boulder clay on the sandstone (No. 11) was not affected by the underlying rock, so could not have been made out of it.

EXCURSION.

Excursion on Saturday, 28th inst., to visit interesting geological section on the branch line of the L. & A. Railway now being constructed. The following are the principal items:—Thick bed of clayband ironstone; thin band of cone-in-cone on top of ironstone; trap dyke; thin dolerite sill in dark shale; dolerite dyke, 31 paces wide; fault of about 24 fathoms of throw; thin bed of fine grained limestone with glacial striae; boulder clay; volcanic rocks.

By the side of the Dusk Water the rather scarce *Scrophularia umbrosa* can be seen in flower and fruit.

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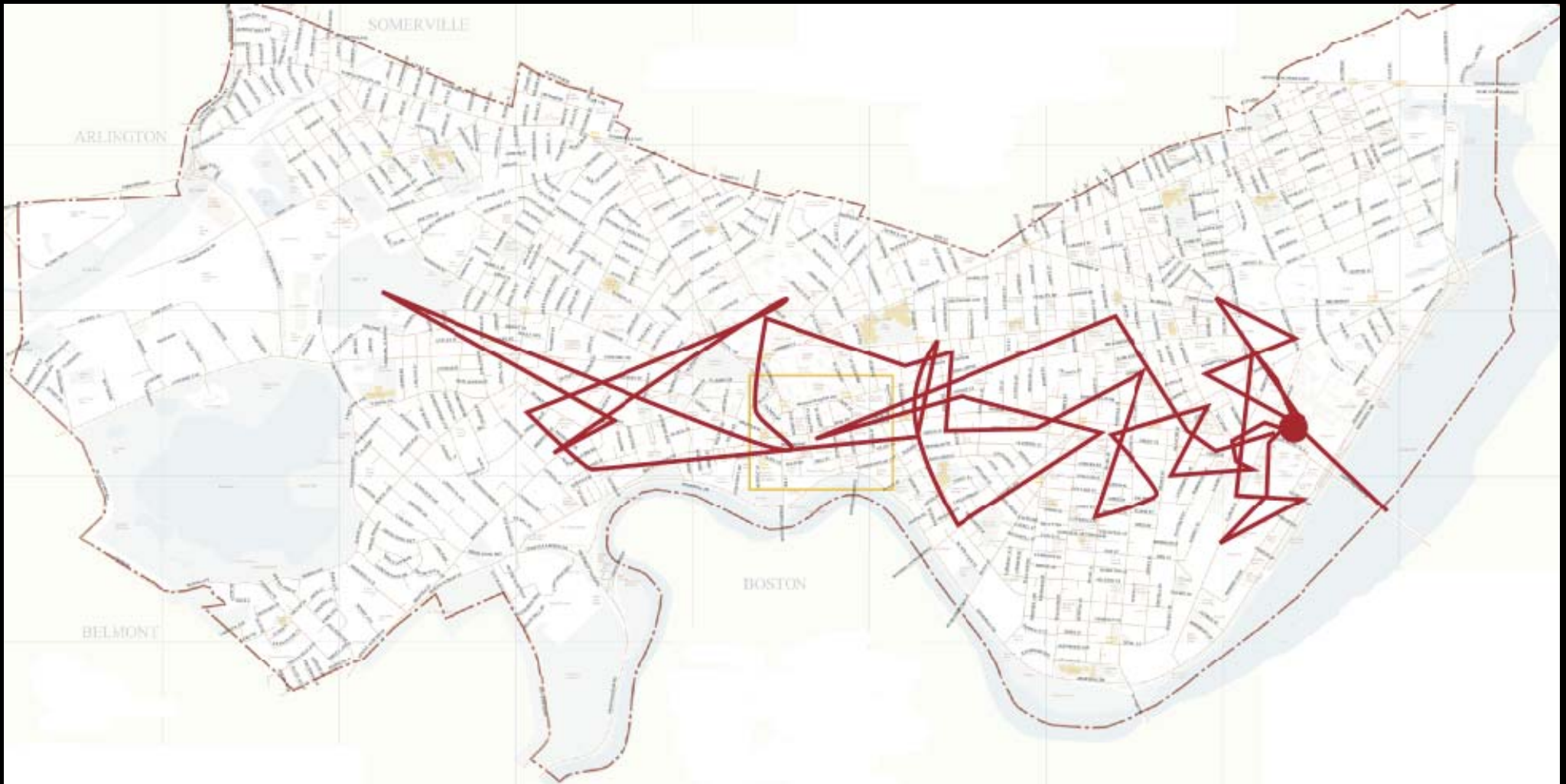
