Develop 3-6 objectives for your project

Objectives are concrete statements describing what the project is trying to achieve. Objectives should be written so that they can be evaluated at the conclusion of a project to determine if they were achieved. While goal statements are designed to be vague, a well-worded objective will be “SMART”:

- *Specific*: include a specific target or accomplishment
- *Measurable*: establish a metric that indicates that an objective has been met
- *Attainable/Realistic*: make sure your objective is achievable given the available resources
- *Time-bound*: achieve objectives within a specified time frame (in this case, December 8th.)

The format for part of your final presentation can be a list of these objectives and proof that you completed them.

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
